BANGOR TO CAMDEN

There are many strange and unusual things in the Wonderful State of Maine. One of the most bizarre is the way we give directions - even the road signs bear watching.

A perfect example of this is that there are two roads marked "1A south" out of Bangor. We know that this is hard to believe. One goes to Stockton Springs and then on to Camden, the other goes to Ellsworth - not a bad town, but not even close to Camden. So dear traveler, take care. Be sure that the Rt. 1A that you take south from Bangor is the one that goes to Hampden, Winterport, Frankfort Prospect and Stockton Springs.

If you have some extra time, we recommend a stop at Fort Knox which is three miles east of Prospect on Rt. 174. Built in the 1840s, the Fort has granite walls twenty feet thick and some of the old guns that once protected the upper reach of the Penobscot River.

Rt. 1A joins Rt. 1 in Stockton Springs - continue south on one until you reach Camden.

The **MAINE STAY INN** is two blocks north of the harbor, on the right side of route one as you enter town.

Driving time from Bangor is an hour and a half.
