CAMDEN TO BANGOR

From the **MAINE STAY INN** turn left on Rt. 1 north.

Points of interest heading north include the town of Belfast (18) which has some nice old houses; Moose Point State Park (23); the Maritime Museum in Searsport (25) and Fort Point State Park in Stockton Springs (30).

In Stockton Springs take Rt. 1A to Bangor. 1A follows the Penobscot River through Winterport, Hampden and on into Bangor. (60)

THE SCENIC ROUTE

The other way to go is to stay on Rt. one toward Bucksport and stop at Fort Knox. Built in 1844, the Fort is now a State Park which is open to visitors from May to November. The view of the Penobscot River from the battlements is truly wonderful. (36)

After touring the Fort get back onto RT. 1 (north) and cross the long suspension bridge over the Penobscot to Verona Island. (38) We can remember marveling at the great river of logs floating down the Penobscot to the lumber mill at Bucksport. The mill is still there but now the logs arrive by truck.

At the end of the causeway which connects Verona Island to Bucksport turn left onto Rt. 15 north. This road follows the east bank of the Penobscot all the way to Bangor. (65)
