CAMDEN TO BETHLEHEM, NH

From the **MAINE STAY INN** turn right and drive south on US 1 through the village of Camden. At Rockport, turn right on Rt. 90 west. (2.5) *

Drive west on 90 until it intersects with Rt. 17 - turn right on Rt. 17 west. (6)

Drive west on 17 to Augusta. (42) With a population of only 22,000 persons, Augusta is certainly not a large city, but it does have a long history (Pilgrims landed here in 1625), a fine State Museum and some wonderful old buildings - perhaps even more important, as the Capital of the State of Maine, Augusta is where our tax money goes.

Stay on 17 until you reach the intersection with Rt. 2 west in East Dixfield. (77)

Proceeding west from Dixfield, Rt. 2 follows the scenic Androscoggin River as it flows through the White Mountain National Forest. You will pass through Rumford (95) and Bethel. A good spot for lunch is the Sunday River Brewing Company www.sundayriverbrewpub.com, 1 Sunday River Road (tel. 207-824-4253) which is on the north side of Rt. 2 just east of Bethel. (120)

After you pass through Gorham, New Hampshire (142) and Randolph keep your eye out for Rt. 115 south. (156)

Take 115 to Rt. 3 in Carroll and turn left toward Twin Mountain and Franconia Notch State Park. (167) Stay on Rt. 302 west for 12 miles and you will see the Adair sign on the right. (179)

Driving time from Camden to Bethlehem is a little over four hours.
