CAMDEN TO DEER ISLE (VIA CASTINE)

From the **MAINE STAY INN** turn left on Rt. 1 north.

Points of interest heading north include the town of Belfast (18) which has some nice old houses; Moose Point State Park (23); the Maritime Museum in Searsport (25); Fort Point State Park in Stockton Springs (30); and Fort Knox (36). Situated on a high bluff overlooking the Penobscot River and the town of Bucksport, the Fort is now a State Park. Be sure to take a flashlight with you so that you can explore the interior passageways. (36)

Continue north on Rt. 1 to Rt. 175 south at Orlando (39) Follow Rt. 175 and Rt. 166 to **CASTINE**. (54)

After touring Castine follow routes head north on Rt. 166 until you come to Rt. 199. Take a right on 199, go through the small village of Penobscot where you will pick up Rt. 175 without making a turn and head toward South Penobscot. There you will turn left on Rt. 177 to Blue Hill. This sounds very confusing, but the road is well marked and you are only going 18 miles. (72)

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BLUE HILL is the home of many writers, artists and potters. We recommend a stop in at least one of the several pottery shops. For an informal lunch try an Adirondack chair on the back lawn of Jean-Paul's Bistro, located on Main St., tel. 207-374-5852 -- the food is good and the view is spectacular. If you prefer an upscale dining experience try the Arborvine www.arborvine.com on the Main Street (tel. 207-374-2119).

After you see Blue Hill continue south on Rt. 15 toward Deer Isle and Stonington. You will pass over Eggemoggin Reach to Little Deer on a high bridge and then turn left to go over the causeway to Big Deer Isle. (66)

There are two villages on the island-Deer Isle (71) and **STONINGTON** (76). The Pilgrim's Inn, 20 Main Street, in Deer Isle village www.pilgrimsinn.com (tel. 207-348-6615), is an outstanding place to stay - and the food gets rave reviews. Stonington is a quaint fishing port at the southern terminus of Rt. 15. If you are looking for a real "Maine kind of place" to eat lunch, try Lily's Cafe.

From Stonington you can take the mail boat (the **MINK**) or the **MISS LIZZIE** over to Isle Au Haut -- call 207 367 5193 for reservations.
