CAMDEN TO FRANCONIA, NEW HAMPSHIRE

From the **MAINE STAY INN** turn right on Rt. 1 south. At Rockport turn right on to Rt. 90 west. (2.5) *

Drive west on 90 until it intersects Rt. 17 - turn right on 17 west. (6) Take Rt. 17 west through Augusta, the Capital of the great State of Maine (44), to Rt. 2 west at East Dixfield. (75) Then turn left of Rt. 2 west.

From Dixfield through the lovely village of Bethel (120), Rt. 2 follows the scenic Androscoggin River as it flows from the Rangeley Lakes toward the sea coast towns of Brunswick and Bath. Stay on Rt. 2 through Randolph and then turn left on Rt. 115 south. This road intersects with Rt. 3 in Carroll. Continue another two miles and turn right on Rt. 302 west. It is 12 miles from Twin Mountain to Bethlehem. When you reach Rt. 116 turn south (left) and drive six miles south to Franconia. Driving time is four hours.

THE SCENIC ROUTE

At Gorham, New Hampshire, turn south on Rt. 16 (142). This scenic highway passes through the Presidential Range of the White Mountains.

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About 12 miles south of Gorham you will come to the Mt. Washington toll road. (150) At 6288 feet above sea level, the peak is the highest point in the United States east of the Mississippi River -- and let me tell you friends, it is **cold** at the top.

Continuing south you will pass through Jackson, Glen and Conway. Turn right on Rt. 112 (the Kancamagus Pass) to Lincoln. The Kancamagus is one of the most beautiful stretches of mountain road in New England. Remember, this is a winding mountain road -- only take it if you have the time to go slowly and enjoy the scenery.

From there you can take Rt. 93 north to Franconia. Driving time from the **MAINE STAY INN** is a little over five hours.
