QUEBEC CITY TO CAMDEN

It is about a two hour drive from Quebec City to the US/Canada border on Canadian route 173 and 73.

The stretch of 201 from the Canadian border to Solon is very scenic, running along the banks of the Kennebec River and through the White Mountains.

In Waterville take Rt. 95 south. In Augusta take Rt. 17 east toward Rockland. With a population of only 22,000 persons, Augusta is certainly not a large city, but it does have a long history (pilgrims landed here in 1625), a fine state Museum and some wonderful old buildings -- perhaps even more important, as the capital of the state of Maine, Augusta is where our tax money goes.

At West Rockport turn left onto Rt. 90 east.

Rt. 90 will bring you to the intersection of Rt. 1. Turn left (north) and go another two miles into the center of Camden. Drive through the village past the head of the harbor and continue north. The High Street Historic District starts at the Camden Public Library. Go two more blocks north and you will come to the **MAINE STAY INN** on the left side of Rt. 1.

Total distance from Quebec City to the **MAINE STAY INN** is 240 miles.
